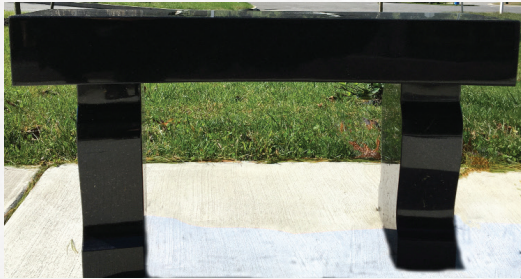


MEMORIALIZATION OPTIONS

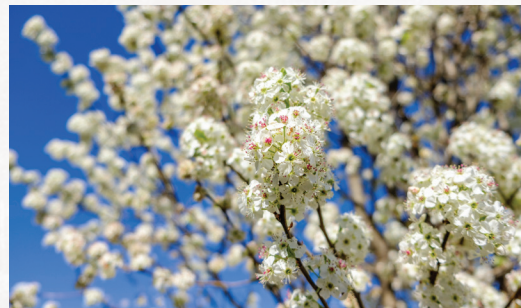

CREMATION ESTATES**

Family cremation estates focus on keeping entire families who choose cremation together. They are an excellent choice for families who want to be laid to rest in a setting that is designed to support the family as a whole. Our cremation estates are beautifully landscaped in a designated section devoted entirely to cremation burial options. Not only do they provide privacy, they also give the family the ability to personalize the resting place of the deceased. Family cremation estates allow families the choice of creating and leaving a legacy for current as well as future generations.

With a private family cremation estate the family has the choice of being inurned in an above ground setting such as a niche cabinet or pedestal. The niche cabinet or pedestal is the focal point of the cremation estate. Each estate honors the family and those buried by memorializing the family name on the niche cabinet. Cabinets and pedestals range in size and can hold the remains of one or more persons.

The family chooses the size of the cabinet or pedestal based upon the number of cremated remains to be inurned. We also offer an option to purchase additional ground graves for cremated remains that would be buried in front of the cabinet or pedestal. Once the family determines the number of burials, the cemetery staff will show available locations that will accommodate the family's wishes. In essence, the family cremation estate is designed for as small or as large of a family as needed.



Upon diocesan management team approval of the design and size of the cremation estate, the family purchases the niche cabinet or pedestal from an authorized monument dealer. Cremation estates offer a unique setting for family members to visit, reflect and pray for the deceased. Cremation estates allow families to choose to be privately inurned or buried close together in a professionally landscaped family plot.

Cremation estates offer numerous above ground cremation options to allow for greater personal choice. We strive to continually offer new and reverent burial choices not only for traditional disposition, but to fulfill the increase in requests from families who have chosen cremation.

Families also have the option to purchase a Garden Permit which allows them to plant and cultivate a lovely garden. In many cases we offer the option to purchase additional memorialization items such as benches, trees and statues.
