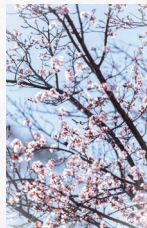
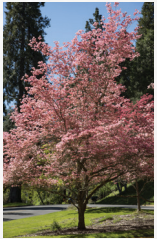

Trees

Donating a memorial tree provides a living tribute to your loved one that withstands time while giving back to the earth. The gift of a memorial tree is symbolic and will grow stronger and blossom with life, year after year. You can choose from four types of beautiful accent trees.

- *White Dogwood - cannot be planted in direct sunlight*
- *Pink Dogwood - cannot be planted in direct sunlight*
- *Cleveland Pear (aka Chanticleer Pear)*
- *Krauter Plum*
- *Crape Myrtle*
- *Crimson King Maple*



Benches

When you donate a memorial bench, you are providing a place for all visitors to sit and rest while spending some time remembering and praying for the dearly departed. We offer several types of benches. Bench selection varies by cemetery location.

- **Granite benches** – these are placed in and near our mausoleums
- **Park benches** – these are placed throughout the ground burial section of the cemetery



Statues

By donating a religious statue you are helping to beautify the cemetery grounds and chapel mausoleums. What better way than to show love and remembrance to your loved one. Statue options vary by cemetery. Speak with our cemetery staff to learn what choices are available.



There are specific locations identified throughout the cemetery as stated in our beautification plan. Speak with a cemetery staff member to see what locations are available. Inscribed markers are included with each of the memorialization items listed. These markers will be placed beside the planting or statue, or on the bench.
